III. Summary information on agricultural holdings in 2013

The tables show summarized grossed-up data for 26 246 agricultural holdings (23 345 holdings of natural persons and 2 901 holdings of legal persons) which reached defined threshold values.

Table 1 presents a comparison of the number of agricultural holdings and their utilised agricultural area.

Compared to 2000 survey the number of agricultural holdings went down negligibly (-1.1%). The number of holdings of legal persons increased; it concerns especially limited liability companies (+23.4%) and joint stock companies (+4.7%), although a distinct decline occurred in the number of cooperatives (-30.3%). On the contrary, the number of holdings of natural persons slightly decreased (-1.6%).

In 2013 in total 3 491 818 ha of agricultural area were utilised, i.e. 44.3% of the total area of the Czech Republic. During the last 13 years the total UAA decreased by 112 582 ha. The possession of the agricultural land changes in the course of time: since 2000 holdings of natural persons gained (+15.2%) while holdings of legal persons lost (-9.4%) certain part of the UAA. The most distinct loss – by one third – was recorded for cooperatives. In 2013 holdings of natural persons held 30.5% of the UAA compared to 25.6% in 2000.

There was also a distinct change in ownership type: while in 2000 almost all utilised agricultural land was rented (92.4%), in 2013 agricultural holdings owned 25.7% of the UAA. Holdings of natural persons owned one quarter of the UAA in 2000 and nearly one half in 2013; in holdings of legal persons the share of own land rose from 1.3% in 2000 to 15.9% in 2013.

The average area utilised by one holding in the Czech Republic accounts for ca 130 ha. The average area of a holding of natural person was 39 ha in 2000 and it grew by 7 ha, i.e. to 46 ha, until 2013. In holdings of legal persons there is an opposite trend: their average area dropped during the same period from 949 ha to 837 ha (-112 ha).
