Methodical comments

Outputs of the Monthly Survey on Livestock Slaughter are included in the publication. The survey includes all registered slaughterhouses in the Czech Republic without regard to their production capacity. The slaughter covers the whole livestock for slaughter, both internal and external origin.

Categories of slaughtering statistics are given in the Regulation (EC) No. 1165/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council and follow up to the surveys on slaughterings in previous years:

Total meat production includes beef, veal, pigmeat, sheepmeat, goatmeat, and horsemeat. Emergency slaughtering is included in the carcass weight in case that meat is fit for human consumption.

Data on poultry production originates from the monthly survey on poultry purchase carried out by the Ministry of Agriculture of the Czech Republic. Live weight is converted into the carcass weight; without giblets since January 2012.

Estimates of slaughtering out of slaughterhouses are provided by the Ministry of Agriculture of the Czech Republic for pigs, sheep, goats, and poultry. Data on cattle slaughtering out of slaughterhouses comes from Central Animal Register (Ministry of Agriculture of the Czech Republic). There is no horse slaughtering out of slaughterhouses in the Czech Republic.

Statistics are published at national level as well as by region (NUTS 3).
