Trend of prices of Construction works and Constructions in 2011

In 2011, **at a rate of growth on average**, prices of **Construction works** decreased by the value on 99.8 (99.9 in 2010). The biggest increase was in 'Construction works for local communication lines' (100.5). The lowest price index was in 'Scaffolding works' (99.2).

Price indices of **Constructions** by the classification CZ-CC in 2011, **at a rate of growth on average**, were ranging between 99.7 and 100.0 in 'Buildings' and were ranging between 99.6 and 100.0 in 'Civil engineering works'.

In 2011, **compared to the previous year on average from the beginning of the year**, price index of **Construction works** was 99.5. Price indices were ranging between 96.8 in 'Scaffolding works' and 102.0 in 'Montage of metal constructions'.

Four-digit price indices of **Constructions** by the classification CZ-CC, **compared to the previous year on average from the beginning of the year**, were ranging between 98.8 in 'Reservoirs, silos and warehouses', 'Bridges and elevated highways' and 'Sports grounds' and 100.4 in 'Long-distance electricity lines'. In two-digit price indices were the most decreasing 'Other civil engineering works' reaching the value 98.9. There was not growth in two-digit price indices.

In long-term point of view, **compared to the average of 2005 on average from the beginning of the year**, price index of **Construction works** decreased by the value on 112.5 (113.0 in 2010). One-digit price indices of **Constructions** decreased the value on 111.9 in 'Buildings' and decreased the value on 113.3 in 'Civil engineering works'.

In long-term point of view, **compared to the average of 2005 on average from the beginning of the year**, index of **Construction costs of Construction output** increased the value on 118.1; index of **Material inputs of Construction output** increased the value on 108.9.
