
## 2.12 OTHER CIVIL RESEARCH (SEO 12)

This socio-economic objective covers all civil research that could not be classified as one of the specific socio-economic objectives. Funding to support R&D abroad (e.g. Framework programmes) is included here as well as fees for participation in international R&D projects. An important item in this case is the money given to the further development of R&D infrastructure. This chapter also includes R&D whose characteristics forbid to classify it into specific chapters (e.g. because of confidentiality).


- The development of the absolute amount of state funding within SEO 12 and this objective's share of the total GBAORD are shown in the following figure, which shows that the absolute amount of support varied in the period 2002–2010. The highest amount (CZK 1,549 million) allocated to this objective was recorded in 2007. The highest proportion of total GBAORD was detected in 2003 (8.5%). The average annual growth in the period 2002–2010 reached 6.8%.
- As mentioned before, this socio-economic objective is not further divided into sub-objectives. Institutional funding was far more common than targeted funding, when the share of institutional funding in 2010 was 91.7% (CZK 1,149,033 thousand) compared to only 8.3% (CZK 103,508 thousand) of targeted funding.
- The largest provider of state funding for this socio-economic objective was the Academy of Sciences the Czech Republic with the share of 62.3% (CZK 780,558 thousand) in 2010. Under this objective the Academy of Sciences financed the R&D infrastructure and administrative costs related to its office. Another major provider was the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports with the share of 30.1% (CZK 376,965 thousand), which funded mostly foreign research programmes and fees to international research institutions. The Grant Agency of the Czech Republic financed 4.5% of other civil research. Under "Others" are listed the Office of the Government of the Czech Republic (1.9%), the Technology Agency of the Czech Republic (1.2%) and also other unspecified amounts (0.1% of SEO 12) related to transfers of funds and administration that could not be clearly assigned to a specific provider.
