





AGE STRUCTURE OF THE UNEMPLOYED 2014







GUESTS IN SPA ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS







MOBILE TELEPHONE NETWORKS – ACTIVE SIM CARDS






INCAPACITY FOR WORK DUE TO DISEASE OR INJURY



ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE OF THE NATIONAL ECONOMY


