## Annotation

Output of the agricultural industry (OAI) at current basic prices presented in total an amount of 117 450.6 mil. CZK in preliminary results for 2011. Cop output reached to 68 621.4 mil. CZK and animal output reached to 43 602.3 mil. CZK. The rest of the total OAI was made up by the agricultural work supplied to the other unit, that were the agricultural services output (2 811.5 mil. CZK) and non-agricultural secondary activities (inseparable) in the amount 2 415.4 mil. CZK. There were the high harvest and output of most items with the exception of potatoes (higher production but sharp cut of prices). The total animal output was higher in the year 2011; the output of pigs, poultry and eggs declined but increased the output of milk.

The estimated volume of subsidies on products for year 2011 amounted to 1 486.6 mil. CZK (of which 76.6 mil. CZK for crop products and to 1 410.0 mil. CZK for animal products). The total volume of subsidies on products in the year 2010 was 1 237.1 mil. CZK.

Output of the agricultural industry at the current constant prices of 2000 amounted to 105 885.3 mil. CZK, composed of crop output (sharing in with 58 662.5 mil. CZK) and animal output (contributing with 43 567.6 mil. CZK).

Crop output 2011 shared in OAI at current basic prices by 58.4 %; dominated with cereals (45.9 %) and industrial crops (25.4 %). Animal output shared in the total output by 37.1 % with the major proportion of milk output (48.5 %) and breeding of pigs for slaughter (20.3 %).

Intermediate consumption (IC) created 72.1 % of the total agricultural output (without subsidies on products). Feedingstuffs represented 35.4 %.of the intermediate consumption.

Income from agricultural activity per full-time labour equivalent (1 AWU), as it is measured by income Indicator A, decreased by 26.2 % in 2011. The deflator (the implicit price index of GDP at market prices), estimated by Eurostat experts for the year 2011 was 100.82 %.
