One part of the reporting units deals only with animal production and has no agricultural land. According to farm structure survey (2005) there are 1 074 such reporting units in the Czech Republic.

The number of holdings farming without agricultural land has changed sharply in comparison with 2000 or 2003. Their number decreased by more than half in comparison to 2000. This significant decrease was caused by the facts that the number of holdings of natural persons went down by 57.6% and holdings of legal persons by 11.7%. But the share of holdings of legal persons in the total number of holdings farming without agricultural land increased from 10.1% to 19.0% during this 5-year period. Holdings farming without agricultural land make up only 2.5% of the total number of holdings at present. From the point of view of agricultural production, business companies & partnerships farming without agricultural land narrowly specialised in livestock production with a high concentration of animals, play a significant role because more than one fourth (37,1%) of the total pig-stock and more than 64,8% of the total poultry-stock is bred there.

A significant group of natural persons without agricultural land can be identified as self-suppliers. They have met some of the additional thresholds set up for the survey but their agricultural production is mostly intended for self-consumption in household.
