## III. Summary information on agricultural holdings in 2010

The tables contain summarized data for 22 864 agricultural holdings (19 781 natural persons and 3 083 legal persons), which reached defined threshold values.

Table 1 shows a comparison of the number of agricultural holdings and the acreage of utilised agricultural area.

During the last ten years the number of agricultural holdings decreased by 13.8%. The decrease in number of natural persons (-16.6%) was compensated for the increase in the number of legal persons (+9.1%), especially of limited liability companies and joint stock companies. Compared to 2000, the number of cooperatives went down by more than one quarter.

The total acreage of the utilised agricultural area is gradually decreasing. In the period 2000-2005, the acreage of UAA declined by 74 984 ha and during the following period it fell by further 45 916 ha. Nowadays, the total area of 3 483 500 ha is utilised, which counts 96.9% of the acreage in the year 2000. In the course of ten years the ownership of the utilised agricultural area shifted among natural and legal persons: while UAA acreage increased for natural persons by 9.7% compared to 2000, legal persons lost almost 8% of their UAA. A significant loss – almost one third of their UAA – was recorded for cooperatives.

Taking into account that the total number of agricultural holdings has decreased more rapidly than the total acreage of UAA, the average acreage of an agricultural holding has risen; currently it counts 152.36 ha. Whereas the average acreage for a natural person counted 38.96 ha at the beginning of the decade it is one quarter higher, i.e. 51.23 ha, at its end. On the contrary, the average acreage for legal persons has declined from 948.23 ha to 801.23 ha in the same period.
