Trend of prices of construction works and constructions in 2nd quarter 2016

In the 2nd quarter 2016, **compared to the previous quarter**, price index of **construction works and constructions** increased by 0.3% (increased by 0.2% in the 1st quarter 2016). The biggest increase for one-digit TSKPstat price indices was in 'Horizontal structures', 'Transport infrastructures' and 'Structures and works of affiliated construction output' (+0.3%). A decrease for one-digit TSKPstat price indices was in 'Trunk line and supply line' (-0.2%).

Price indices of **constructions** by the classification CC in the 2nd quarter 2016, **compared to the previous quarter**, were ranging between 100.1 and 100.3 in 'Buildings' and were ranging between 99.8 and 100.4 in 'Civil engineering works'.

In the 2nd quarter 2016, **compared to the previous year**, price index of **construction works and constructions** increased by 1.1%. Price indices for one-digit TSKPstat were ranging between +0.7% in 'Vertical and complete structures', 'Trunk line and supply line' and 'Other structures and works, demolition works' and +1.2% in 'Transport infrastructures' and 'Structures and works of affiliated construction output'.

Four-digit CC price indices of **constructions, compared to the previous year**, were ranging between 100.4 in 'Long-distance telecommunication lines', 'Long-distance electricity lines' and 'Local electricity and telecommunication cables' and 101.5 in 'Other sport and recreation constructions'. In two-digit CC price indices were the most increasing 'Other civil engineering works' reaching the value 101.3. There was not decline for two-digit CC price indices.

In long-term point of view, **compared to the average of 2005**, price index of **construction works and constructions** increased the value on 113.4. One-digit CC price indices of **constructions** increased the value on 112.8 in 'Buildings' and increased the value on 114.2 in 'Civil engineering works', compared to the average of 2005.

Construction costs of construction output, compared to the previous quarter, increased by 0.6%. **Material inputs of construction output** decreased by 0.5%. In long-term point of view, **compared to the average of 2005**, the value for index of **construction costs of construction output** increased the value on 118.2; index of **material inputs of construction output** decreased the value on 109.1.
