Comment

According to the Livestock census as at 1.4.2016 the numbers of cattle and pigs grow up y-o-y, numbers of sheep, goats, horses and poultry went down.

Number of cattle increased by 8 526 heads y-o-y (+0.6%). Number of cows increased by 3 645 heads (+0.6%) and number of suckler cows grow up by 3.6% to 211.2 thousand heads.

Number of pigs increased by 50.3 thousand heads (+3.2%) in comparison with the same stage of the previous year, of which number of sows by 0.8 thousand heads (+0.8%).

Number of poultry went down by 1 194.2 thousand heads (-5.3%), of which numbers of hens went down by 181.0 thousand heads (-2.9%).

There was y-o-y decrease in sheep numbers by 13 201 heads, i.e. by 5.7%.

Numbers of horses went down by 4.7% y-o-y, i.e. to 32.1 thousand heads.
