COMMENTARY

As at 15 July 2017 the Czech Statistical Office processed estimates of yield and harvest of field peas, poppy, and selected fruit and vegetables; and improved estimates of production of basic cereals (common wheat, rye, barley, oats and triticale), rape, early potatoes, strawberries, cherries and sour cherries.

According to these improved estimates, the production of basic cereals (including triticale but excluding maize for grain and other cereals) is awaited to be 6 709 thous. tonnes with their average yield of 5.32 t/ha. The estimated production of basic cereals decreased by 236 thous. tonnes (-3.4%) compared with the June estimate. In comparison with 2016 final results it decreased by 1 020 thous. tonnes (-13.2%).

The common wheat production is expected to reach 4 665 thous. tonnes (of which 4 462 thous. tonnes of common winter wheat); it went down by 14.5 % in comparison with the 2016 harvest. The total barley harvest is supposed to decrease by 12.3 % and to amount to 1 619 thous. tonnes (of which spring barley harvest should be 1 090 thous. tonnes; i.e. by 9.7 % less than in 2016). The yield estimates account for 5.68 t/ha for common winter wheat (6.57 t/ha in the previous year), 4.71 t/ha for rye (4.98 t/ha in 2016), and 4.73 t/ha for spring barley (5.45 t/ha in 2016).

The harvest of early potatoes (harvested before 30 June) should reach 22 thous. tonnes with its estimated average yield of 19.84 t/ha. The rape harvest should amount to 1 199 thous. tonnes; i.e. by 160 thous. tonnes less (-11.8%) than in the previous year. Its average yield is expected to be 3.04 t/ha (3.46 t/ha in 2016). The poppy harvest should be 23 thous. tonnes, i.e. less than in 2016 (29 thous. tonnes). Its estimated yield decreased to 0.70 t/ha (0.80 t/ha in 2016).
