

28. SPORT

Data on rankings achieved by Czech sport representatives at world and European championships are taken over from an archive of documents on the website of the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sports and then grossed up. The Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sports also provides data on subsidies from the state budget. Results of Czech sport representatives at the Olympic Games are acquired from the website of the Czech Olympic Committee. Data on sport unions and associations are provided by the Czech Union of Sports on the basis of its own registry. Only sports included in the list of summer and winter Olympic sports are monitored.

Notes on Tables

Table 28-6 Memberships of selected sport unions and associations

The table gives data for twenty sports selected according to the criterion of the membership size in 2016. Only sports included in the list of Olympic sports are monitored. The data were obtained from the registry of membership of the Czech Union of Sports (CUS) as at 31 December of the given year. The data collection was organised according to instruction of the Chairman of the Czech Union of Sports in all entities associated in the CUS.

Table 28-7 Allocation of state budget finances to support sport activities

The data are based on documents on allocation of the state budget published in the archive of documents on the website of the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sports.
