Lifelong learning statistics in the Slovak Republic

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Lifelong learning statistics in the Slovak Republic as an important part of the national statistical system consist of the four basic components, which are statistical information on (1) completed education of individuals, (2) the national education system, (3) lifelong learning and (4) financial flows in the frame of education. Data sources for this information are various statistical surveys and administrative data. The conference paper is discussing on the most important data sources and figures characterizing educational system and lifelong learning status in Slovakia including data from survey on continuing vocational training in enterprises (CVTS3) and Adult education survey (AES). Financial data on lifelong learning are presented in the terms of national accounts. In the last part of this paper are shown selected figures linking data on education and labour market based on data from LFS, EU SILC and AES.
